Truly, from the heart, thank you for being part of it.

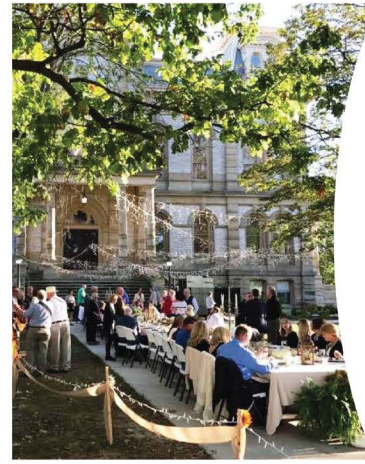
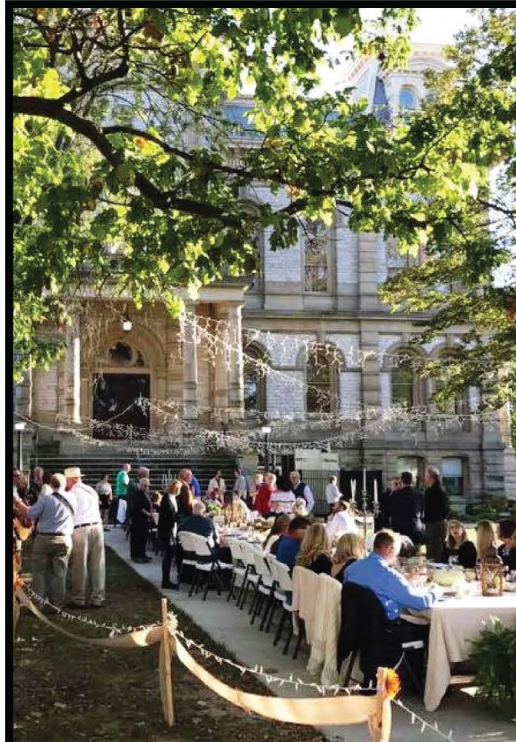

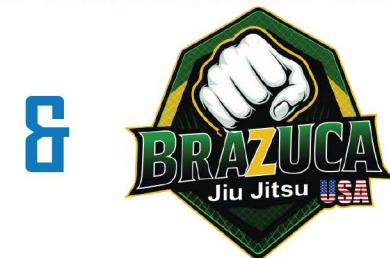
